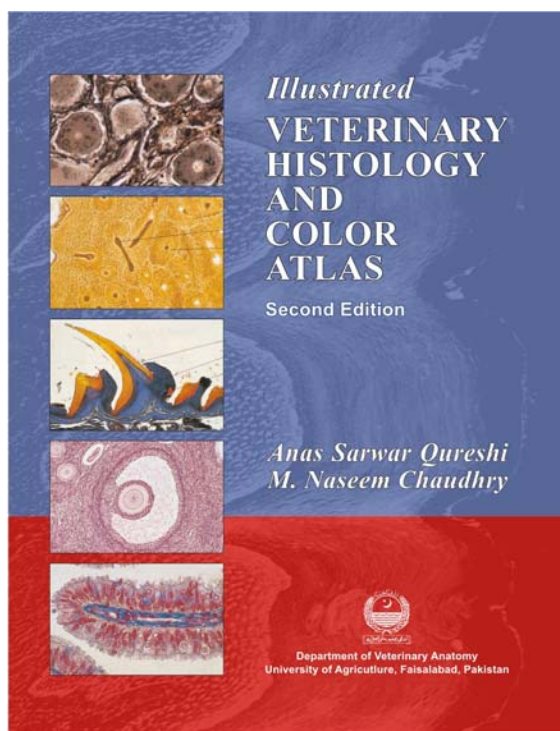

Spread over 44 pages, there are 246 selectively stained and appropriately magnified color micrographs which depict cytology, basic tissues and systemic histology of the domestic animals. Their labeling and listing is so perfect that one finds little difficulty in reaching them. This COLOR ATLAS is a valuable addition which has enlarged the scope, utility, as well as the title of the Second Edition, as follows “**Illustrated Veterinary Histology and Color Atlas**”. With time, the manuscript seems to have really matured, as have its authors and their portraits.

Because of this popularity and demonstrative ability, 189 hand drawn black and white illustrations remain undisturbed. As such, sufficient microscopic structures discussed in the opposing pages continue to create the first and lasting visual impression in the minds of new comers.

Main distinguishing features among resembling tissues/organs have always bothered both the teachers and the taught. Summarized in 12 tables previously, these peculiarities have now been expanded to 20 exhaustive tables titled “REVIEW OF HISTOLOGY”. Inclusion of haematological norms of the domestic animals, hints on embryonic origins of basic tissues and listing of major pituitary hormones may be of interest to the students having clinical interests. A quick recapitulation and revision is thus facilitated which satisfies the primary requirements of all types of students/examinations.

It is pleasure to see what was once a Lab. Manual has developed into an ATLAS showing these many profusely labeled illustrations. May this process of growth and improvement pass on to the next generation of teachers and taught.
